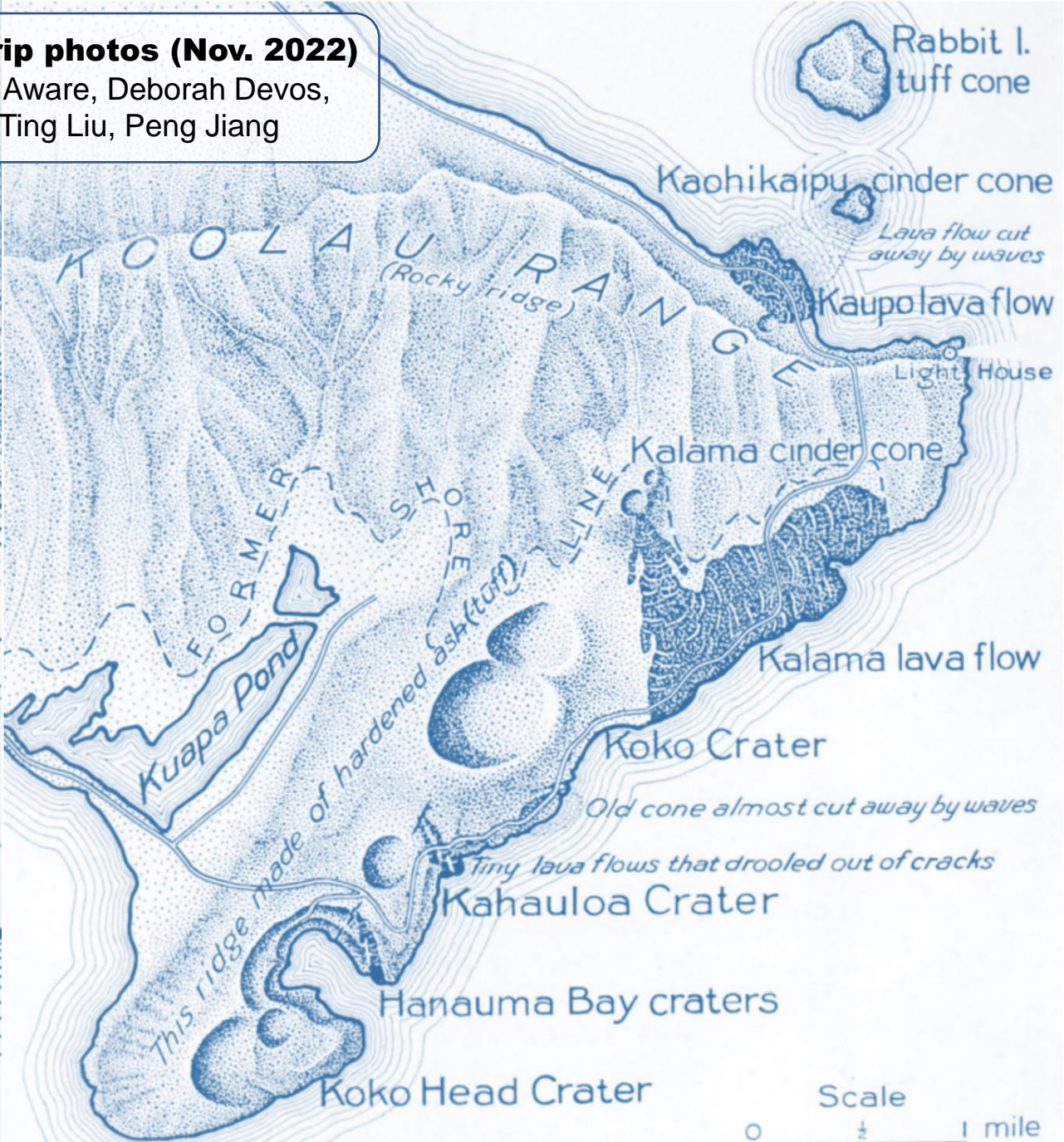
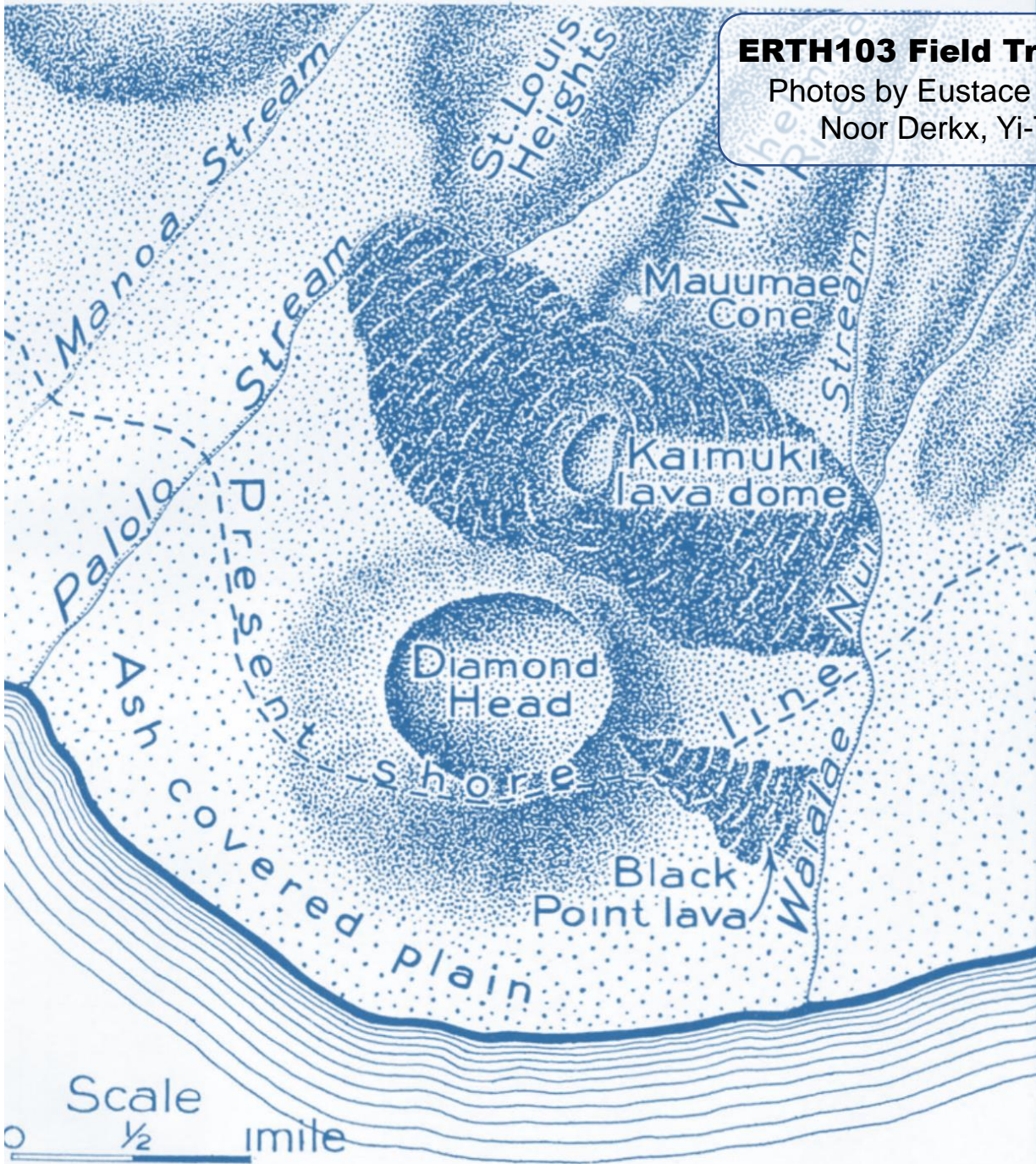

Rainy start at Koko head (Rejuvenation, Koko Fissure, Nested craters, Hawai'i Kai history)



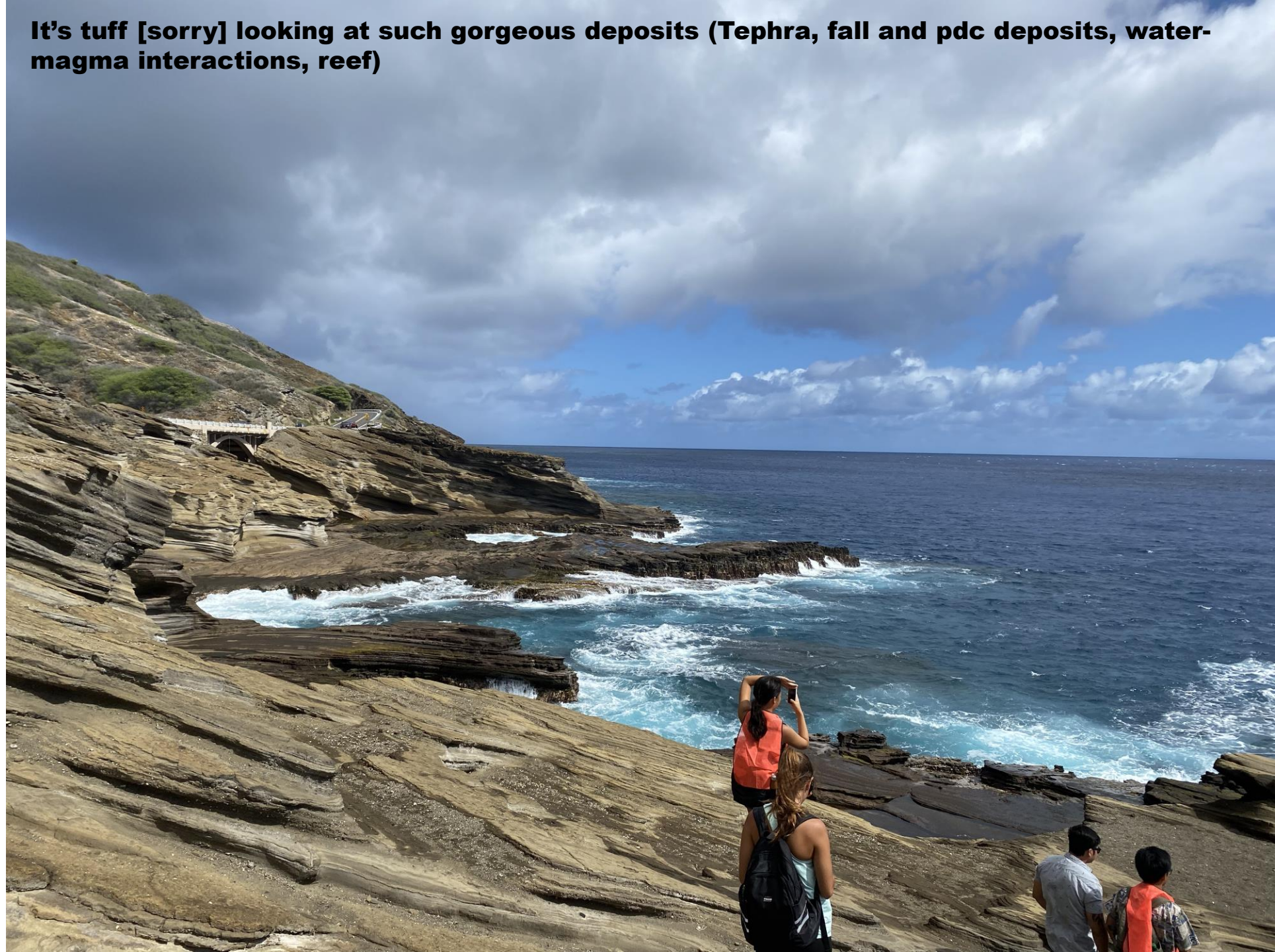
The group start to dry...and actually gets a view
